

# Record Cover Frames



Savers/Value Village stocks an endless supply of retro records with cool cover art. Snip them up and you'll have an artistic way to display your favorite pics. At just .99 each, you can easily fill up a full wall with frames and add instant interest to the dorm.



## Cost:

- \$0.99 Records (each)

## You Will Need:

- Record jackets
- Sharp craft knife
- Foil tape (to edge frames, available at craft stores)
- Photo corners
- Binder clips

## Instructions:

**Step 1:** Measure the size of your pictures and determine what size to cut your frames.

**Step 2:** Using the sharp craft knife, cut out a hole for your picture in the record jacket – position it in an area where it won't interfere with the artwork too much.

**Step 3:** Cut the foil tape into lengths that fit the inside edges of the picture hole.

**Step 4:** Place foil tape along the edges of the picture hole (with half the tape width along the front edge and half along the back).

**Step 5:** Attach photo corners to the back of the record cover at each photo hole edge, and place your photo in the photo corners (you can also tape photos directly to the back of the record cover).

**Step 6:** Clip a binder clip to the top of the record cover and hang using the clip.
